Whether you're in Rome to visit monuments, snap up luxury goods, do some professional work or relax with a book, <u>Hotel Anahi</u> is well-located and well-equipped. A five-minute walk brings you to the Piazza del Popolo, one of Rome's grandest public squares and home to multiple centuries-old churches, particularly <u>Santa Maria del Popolo</u> basilica, which houses works by Raphael, Bernini and Caravaggio. Two of Rome's most famous shopping streets, Via di Ripetta and Via del Corso, are equally close. And within the hotel's 19th-century building — whose rooms and common areas feature William Morris wallpapers, herringbone floors and other touches of late 1800s design — you can take advantage of the lobby's antique desks, plush couches and selection of multilingual literary works.
